⦿ Skills

- Create audio recordings of stories or poems; add drawings or other visual displays to stories or recounts of experiences when appropriate to clarify ideas, thoughts, and feelings. (LA)
- Write opinion pieces in which they introduce the topic or book they are writing about, state an opinion, supply reasons that support the opinion, use linking words (e.g., because, and, also) to connect opinion and reasons, and provide a concluding statement or section. (LA)
- With guidance and support from adults, use a variety of digital tools to produce and publish writing, including in collaboration with peers. (LA)

Introduction

For this final project, your child is going to write an opinion piece about the novel. For this project she will use an online presentation tool called Emaze. You can sign up for a free subscription. If you prefer, you can use Google Slides, PowerPoint, or another slideshow presentation tool for this project instead.

NOTE: You may want to choose images beforehand for your child to use. Online image searches (including those in Emaze) may return some unexpected or inappropriate results. Also be aware that Emaze's free version does not allow you to control privacy settings or export your child's presentation.
